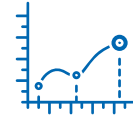

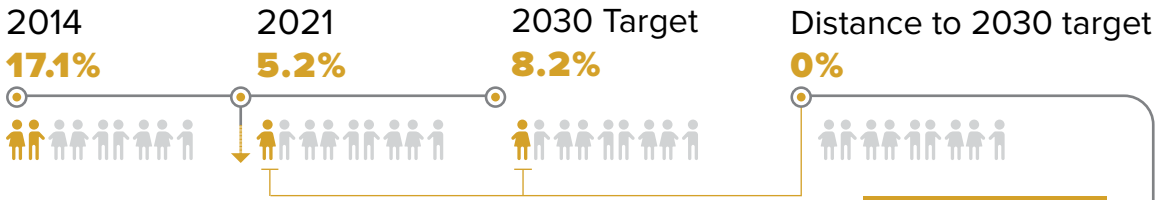

Prevalence of malnutrition among children under 5 years of age (%)

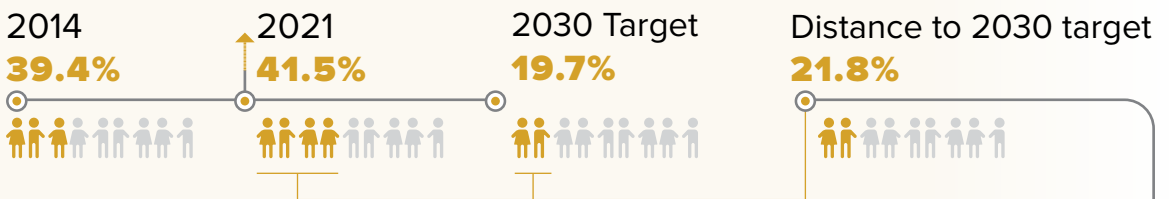

Prevalence of anaemia in children aged 6–59 months (%)

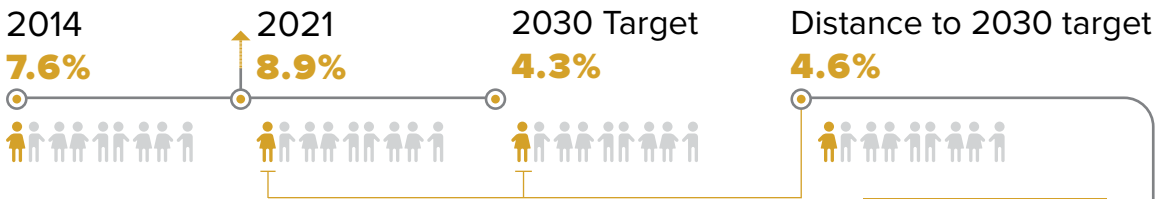

Maternal mortality ratio per 100,000 live-births

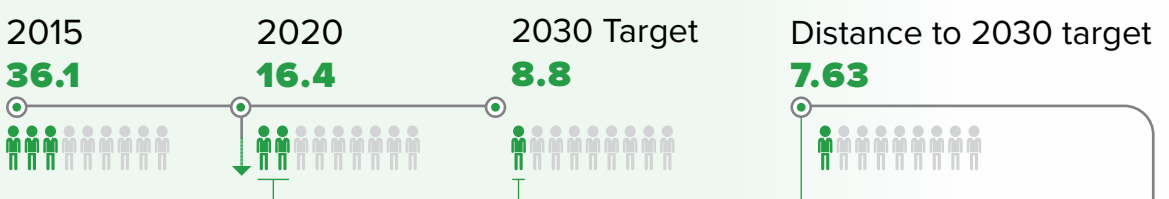

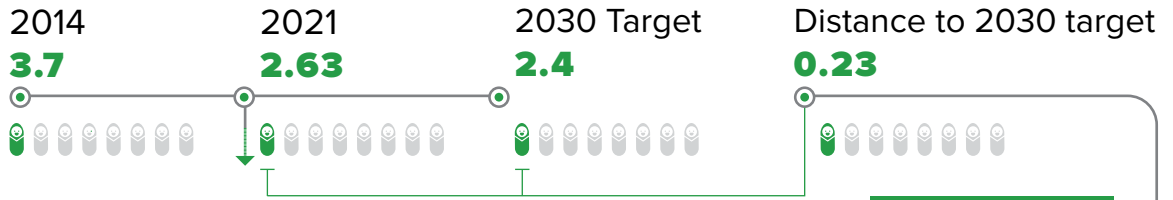

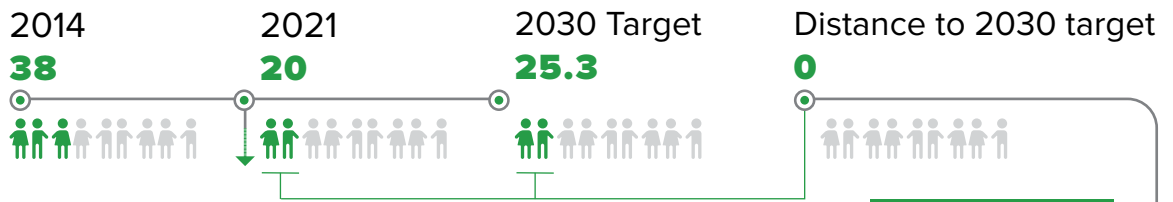

Neonatal mortality rate per 1000 live-births



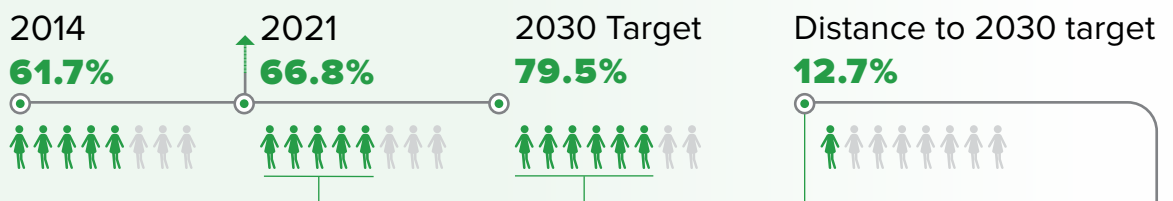

Under-five mortality rate per 1000 live-births



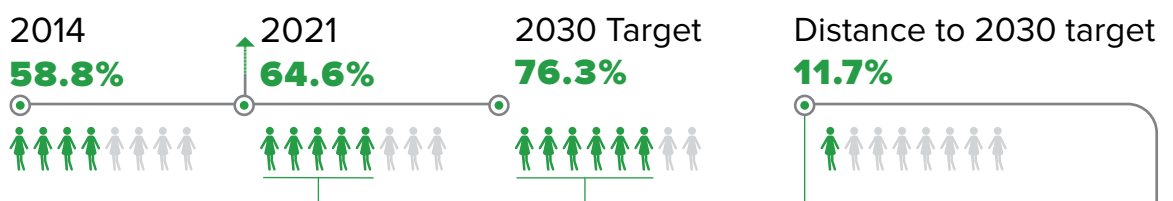

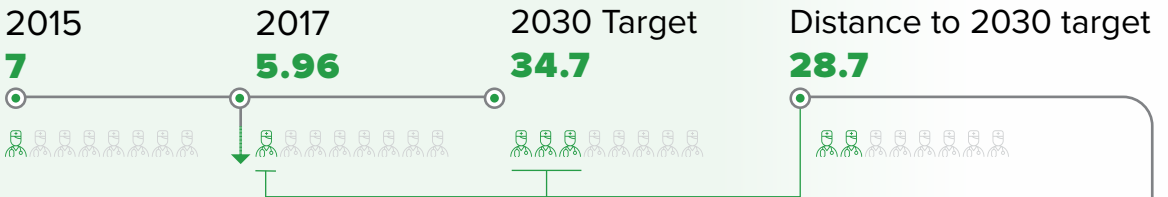
Percentage of births attended by skilled health personnel (%)

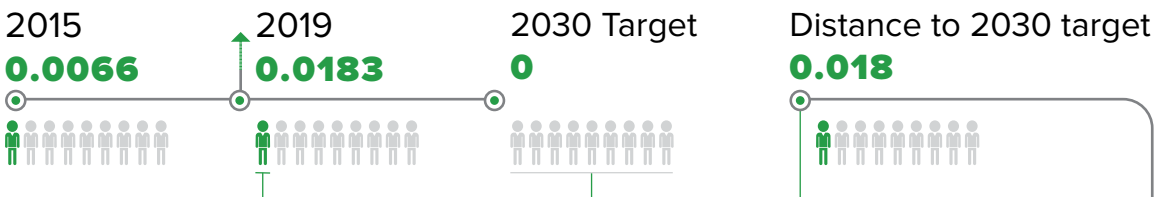
Number of medical doctors per 10,000 population

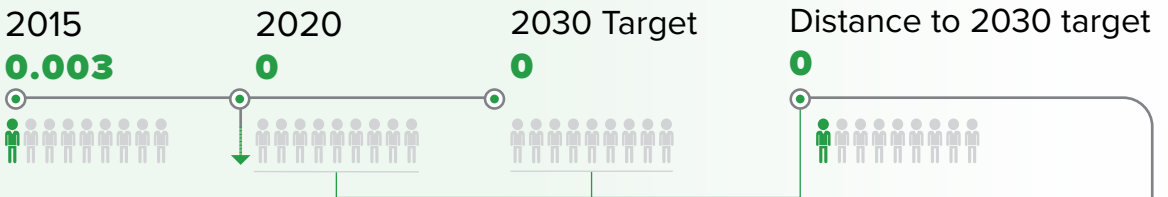
Number of new HIV infections per 1000 uninfected population

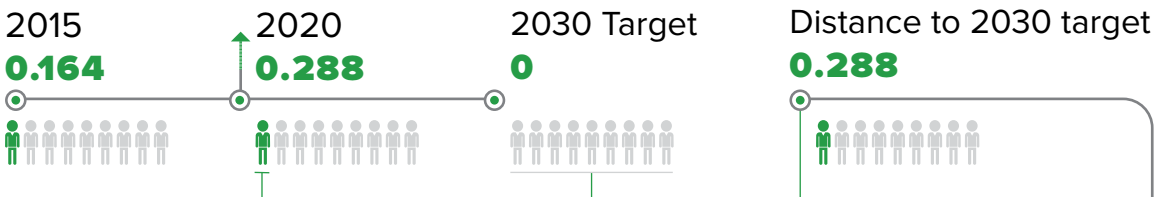
Malaria incidence per 1000 population

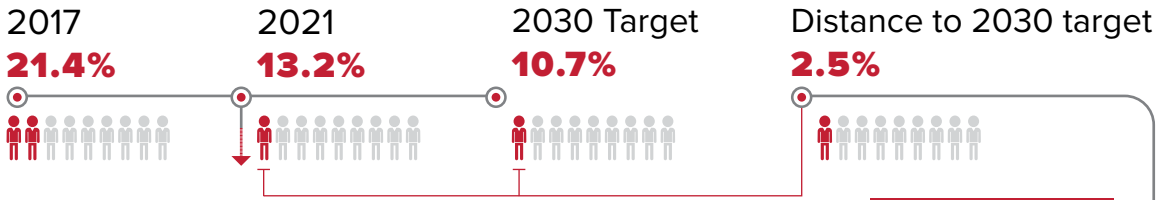

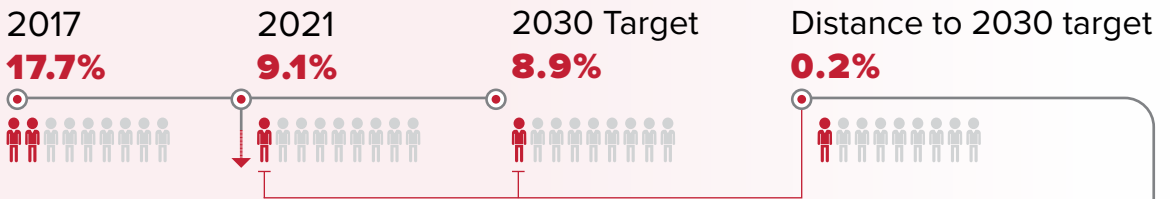


Illiteracy rate (10 years and above) (%)



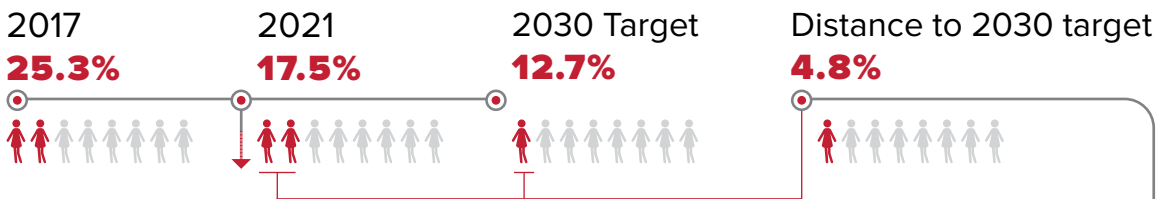

Illiteracy rate, male (10 years and above) (%)



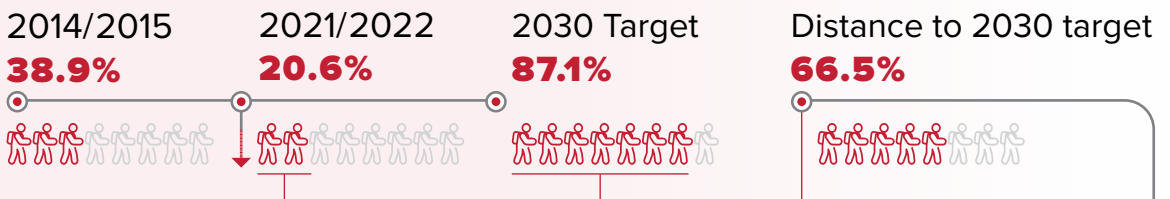

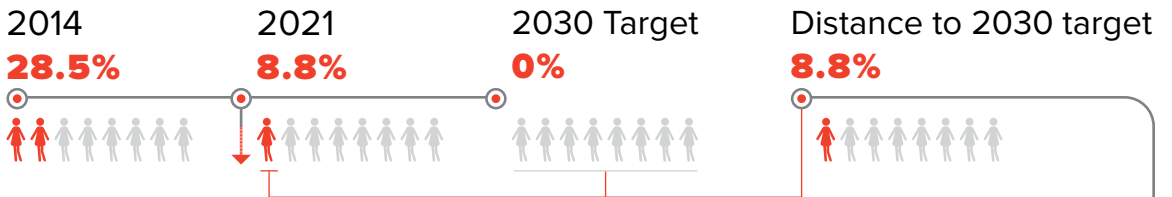
Percentage of schools equipped for students with disabilities (%)

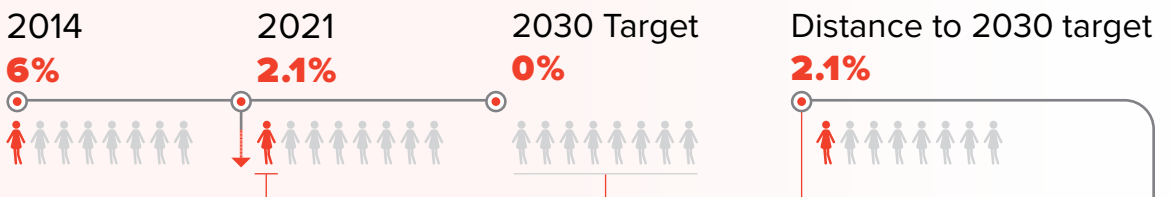


Percentage of ever-married women aged (15-49) subjected to physical violence (%)



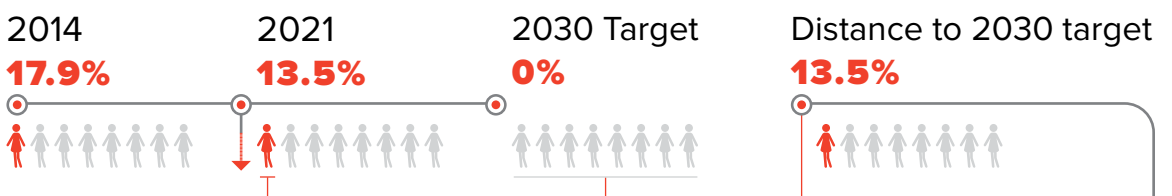

Percentage of ever-married women aged (15-49) subjected to sexual violence (%)



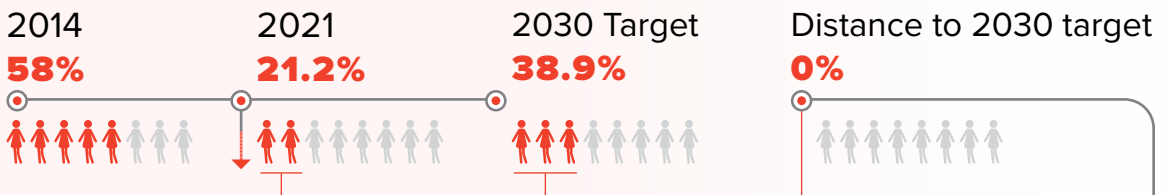

Number of seats held by women in national parliaments

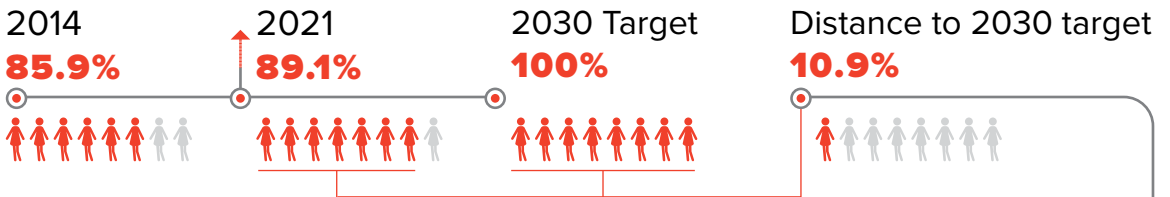

Percentage of married women aged (15–49) years who make their own decisions regarding their health care (%)



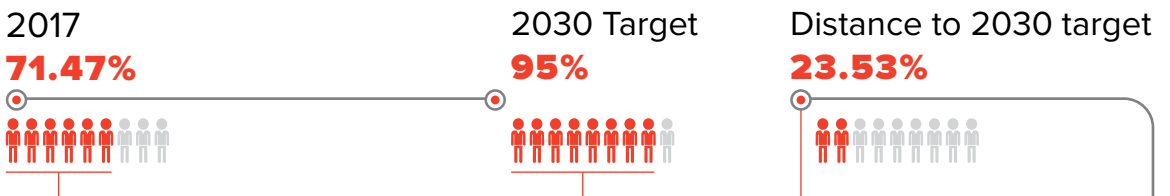

Percentage of married women aged (15–49) years who make their own decisions regarding family planning methods (%)



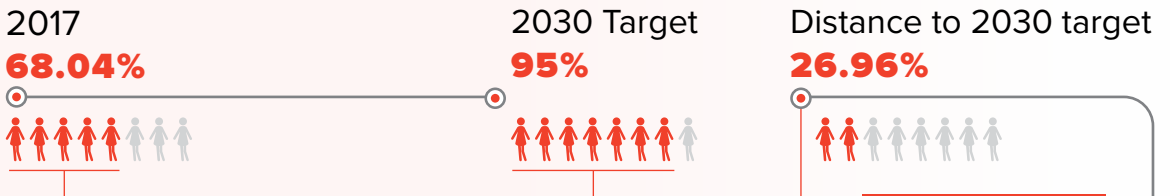

Percentage of individuals using mobile phones (4 years and above) (%)



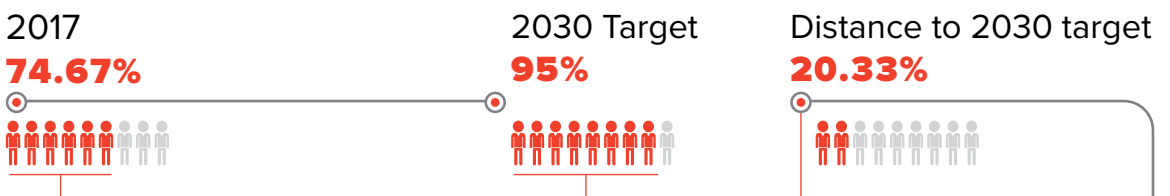

Percentage of individuals using mobile phones, male (4 years and above) (%)

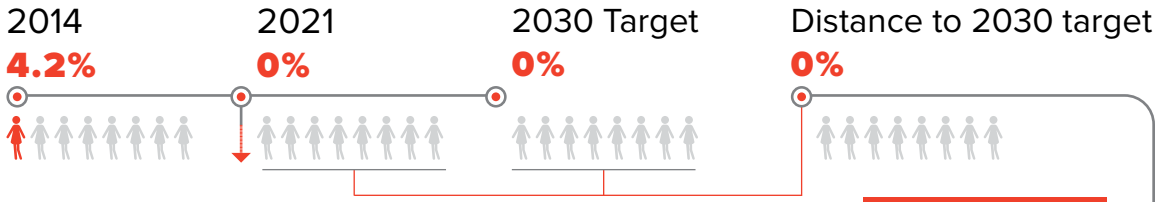

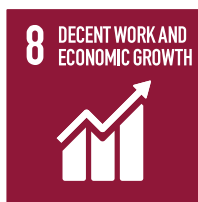


Percentage of households with access to electricity (%)

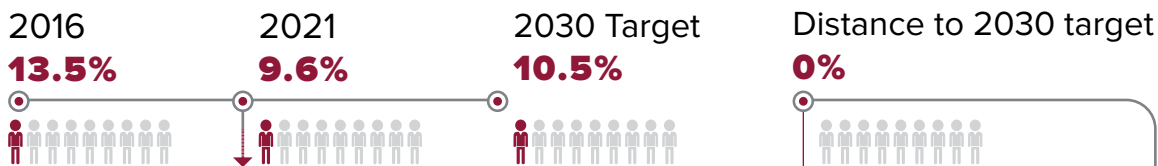

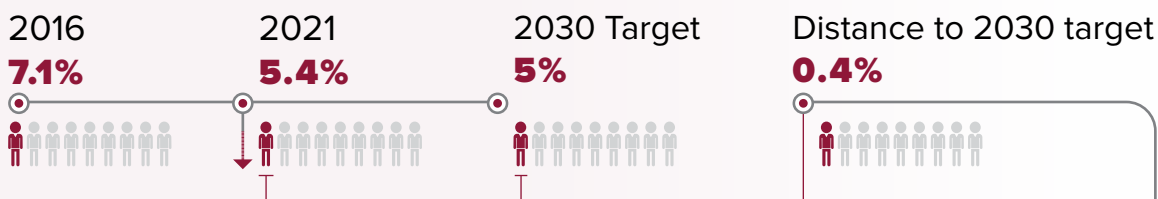

Unemployment rate, male (%)

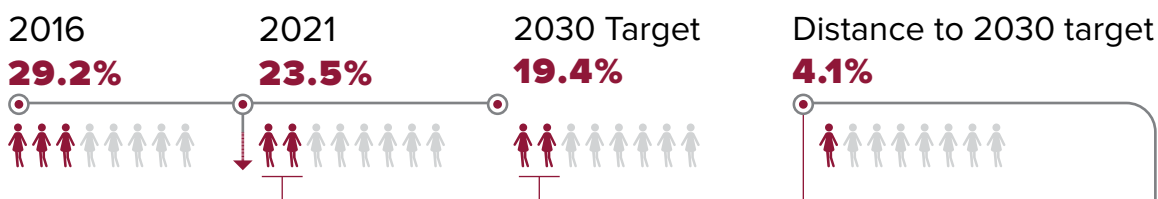

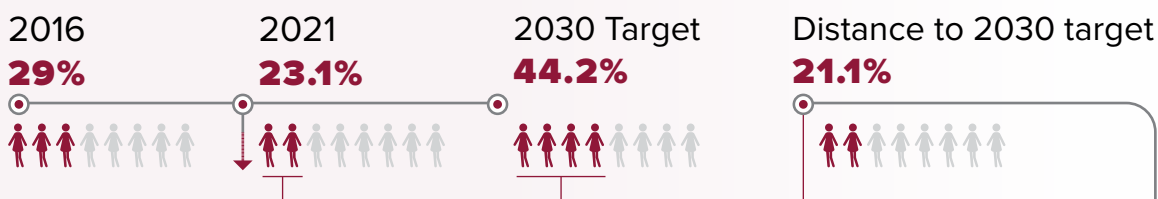

Percentage of females in the labor force (%)

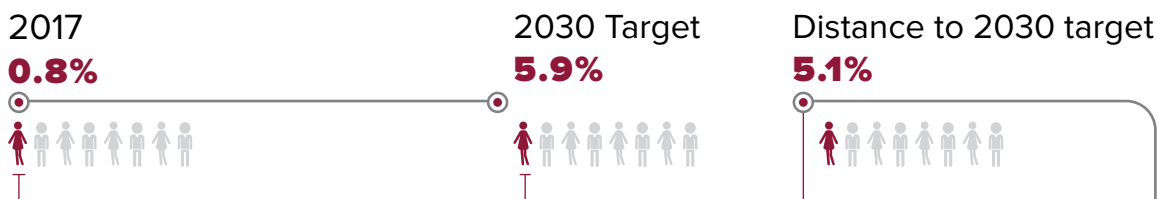

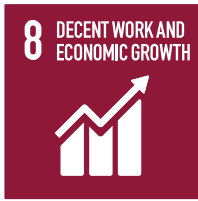
Percentage of youth aged (16-19) years who receive training (%)



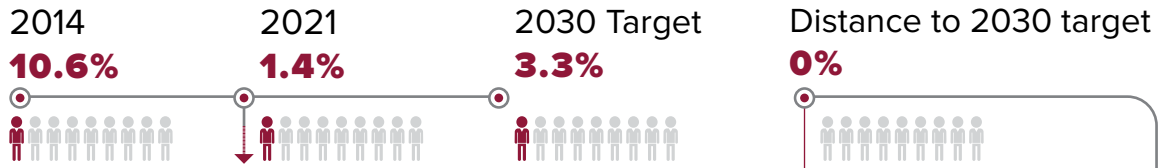

Percentage of children aged (5-17) years engaged in child labor (%)

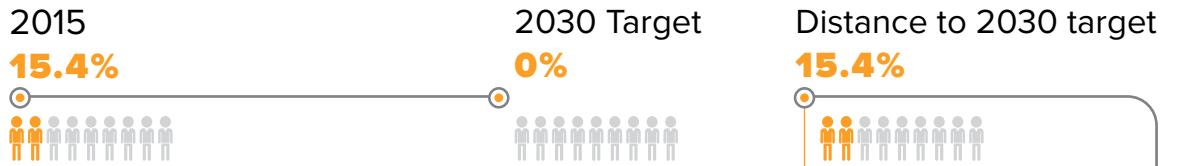

Percentage of population living in unsafe informal settlements (%)



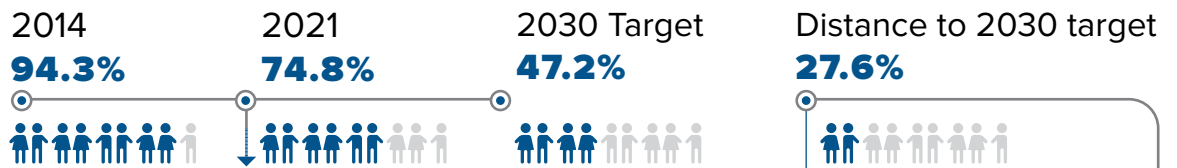

Percentage of children who experienced any violent means of behavior control (%)



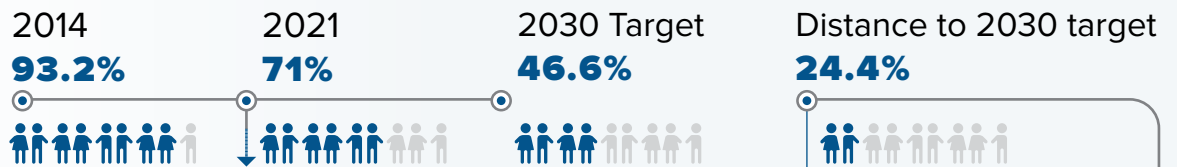

Percentage of children who experienced psychological punishment (%)



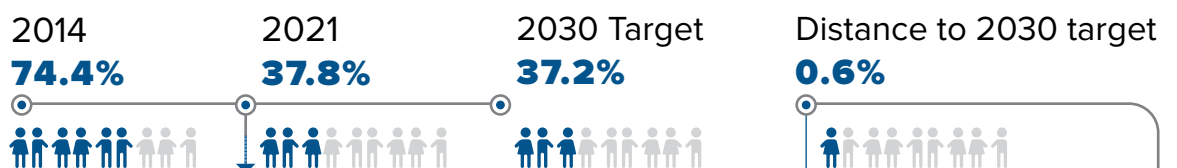

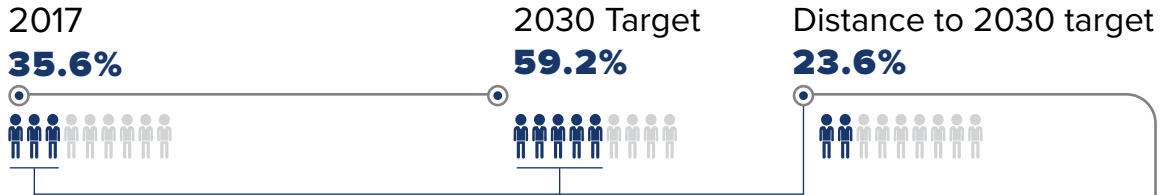

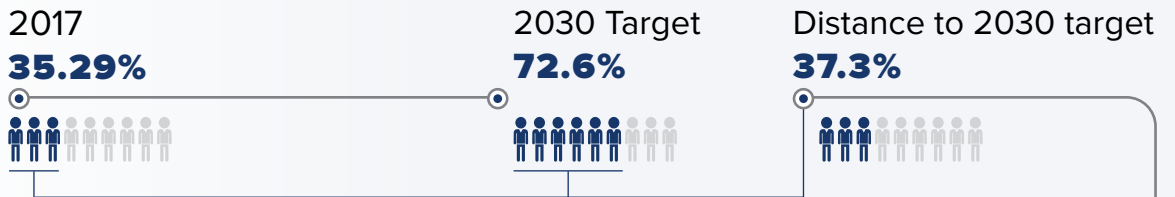
Percentage of individuals using the internet (4 years or above) (%)
