

## H.E. Ambassador Marie-Antoinette Zitane ROSE-QUATRE Chief Executive Officer AFRICAN PEER REVIEW MECHANISM (APRM)



Ambassador Marie-Antoinette Rose-Quatre currently serves as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the APRM Continental Secretariat following her appointment by the 33rd Summit of the African Peer Review Forum of Heads of State and Government and formal endorsement by the 37th Ordinary Session of the African Union Assembly of Heads of State and Government. In this role, she will be leading the organization towards becoming a high-performing governance self-assessment mechanism.

Ambassador Rose-Quatre has over two decades of experience in the fields of politics, diplomacy, public policy, management, media and communications. Her career spans roles such as journalist; a politician, as a Member of Parliament and



a diplomat as the accredited Seychelles Ambassador to several AU Member States Ambassador of Seychelles to Republic of South Africa.

Indeed, Ambassador began her career as a journalist before becoming Editor-in-Chief of a Political newspaper. She then rose to becoming a proportionate Member to the Seychelles National Assembly and was later appointed Chief Executive Officer of the United Seychelles Party in 2009 where she led political reforms to change the political landscape and benefit future generations.

In March 2012 Ambassador Rose-Quatre became the leader of the majority Party in the Seychelles Parliament. Ambassador Rose-Quatre has led the Majority Party in Parliament through important and historical legislative reforms. She worked closely with the Executive in the legislative process which included strategic policy reviews. Additionally, she also chaired several Committees in the National Assembly including her active engagements as a member of the Women's Parliamentary Committee as well as the then Reform and Modernization Committee - supporting the Parliament's transformation process.

Ambassador Rose-Quatre was appointed as an Ambassador of the Republic of Seychelles in 2016. In 2017, she represented the Republic of Seychelles as the accredited Ambassador to several AU Member States, at SADC and COMESA.

Ambassador Rose-Quatre holds a BA (Double Major) in Communications studies & English & Comparative Literature, and MA (Distinction) in Global Diplomacy. She is married and has two sons.
