Mr. Cogut has led Pegasus to comprehensive partnerships with UNDP, IICA and UCLG Africa, among others.

From 1990 to 1995, Mr. Cogut was a Founding Partner of Apollo Advisors, L.P. In addition, Mr. Cogut has been an active philanthropist in the fields of improving education, building civil society and championing environmental and health issues.
