



Percentage of population having a hand-washing facility with soap and water (%)


































Percentage of currently married women aged (15–49) years, who are using any method of contraception (%)

## ■ Number of medical doctors per 10,000 population




## Number of new HIV infections per 1000 uninfected population
































Percentage of married women aged (15–49) years who make their own decisions regarding their health care (%)












Percentage of married women aged (15–49) years who make their own decisions regarding family planning methods (%)

Percentage of individuals using mobile phones, male (4 years and above) (%)




Percentage of women aged (15-17) who are currently married (%)






























## ✓ Percentage of children aged (5-17) years engaged in child labor (%)






## ✓ Percentage of population living in unsafe informal settlements (%)






# Percentage of children who experienced any violent means of behavior control (%)

## **✓** Proportion of children who experienced physical punishment (%)


