




Percentage of married women aged (15–49) years who make their own decisions regarding family planning methods (%)











## **■** Death rate due to road traffic injuries per 100,000 population



















Percentage of currently married women aged (15–49) years, who are using any method of contraception (%)



Percentage of currently married women aged (15–49) years, who are using any modern method of contraception (%)




